# ASEAN-JAPAN TECHNICAL THEATER AND DESIGN WORKSHOP 2006

"Acting Together and Advancing Together"

Sinag Arts Foundation and the Japan Foundation's mission of training technical theater people in Asia will finally come true in March 2006, as we co-organize TECHNICAL THEATER AND DESIGN WORKSHOP 2006: "Acting Together and Advancing Together". This big workshop will run from March 13 through March 26, 2006 at Sinag Arts Studio in Mandaluyong City, Philippines.

Theaters experts from Japan and the Philippines will facilitate workshops of Technical Directors, Sound Designers, Lighting Designers, Stage Designers and Art Administrators. Participants are expected to come from all ASEAN countries. In this 16-day hands-on workshop, the goal is to advance the level of knowledge and skills in the areas of Design and Technical Theater. The culminating activity is an actual theater production which is an original new musical, "Zsa Zsa Zaturnah".

This workshop is a collaborative project with the Japan Foundation.

- □ → JAPAN FOUNDATION OFFICE accepts application forms at its branch offices in Indonesia, Malaysia, and Thailand. Applicants in Singapore may submit to the branch office in Malaysia.
- □ + All application forms should be at SINAG ARTS FOUNDATION on or before **Jan. 15, 2006**.
- □ ★ Results of screening: All the applicants for scholarship will be informed by e-mail before February 15, 2006. Self-enrolled applicants will be formally accepted upon payment.
